



We want to update you with our plans for summer camp for this summer.

**Our plan is to operate our camping programs as scheduled.**

Creating a quality, healthy and safe camping environment is a partnership between you and us. You can expect the following from us:

- We will continue to monitor and comply with any local, state or federal guidelines.
- Increased cleaning and sanitation. We will step up and increase our scheduled cleaning of comfort stations, common areas and dining areas.
- Hand Sanitizer Stations everywhere. We will now require that every activity or merit badge session starts with hand washing.
- Food Service and Dining. We are evaluating options to continue to provide the best and safest food service we can. Continued Social Distancing requirements may require us to increase the number of meal shifts in our dining halls allowing for more separation for our campers, moving to cafeteria style feeding or providing fresh hot meals to your unit at your campsite, or at other locations on our properties. We will do whatever we need to do to keep our campers and staff safe!
- Activities and merit badge sessions. We may need to reduce our class sizes or change the locations of our classes to allow for social distancing. This could also include changing our schedule including offering additional activity and badge work in the evening.

We need some things from you too:

- Make sure your scouts are healthy when they leave for camp. It is very important that our scouts have their temperatures at home before they meet up with the troop to carpool to camp. Anyone with a temp of 100 or more will not be permitted to attend camp. Please know that we will retake temps upon arrive at camp.
- Step up camper hygiene. Showers as needed and lots of handwashing in the campsite.





- Do your best to pay your camp fees on time. We know that units aren't meeting in the usual way and some families are living other places. We will work with units on a plan on fees that you were unable to collect once you have done your best to collect fees. Please know that your deposits or payments are not at risk. If we are unable to operate this season or campers have an issue due to COVID-19, we will offer you several options, including a full refund.

We are aware that schools could reopen and extend into the summer. We are preparing options that would include allowing you to reschedule you week to a different date. We will even extend the length of our season if necessary.

Our team will continue to keep you informed, as necessary, to any change in our plans.

We just wanted to let you know that we are prepared, continue to hire staff, improving our camps and getting ready to provide you with the best camping experience. Thank you choosing us and for your support. We look forward to your visit.
