The shotgun range may be available for Troop use. You must provide one NRA certified Instructor for each 8 firing positions, a range safety officer and your own 12 gauge shotguns and targets.		
During the Spring and Fall canoes and kayaks are available for rent by qualified individuals.		
All camps have an orienteeing course, and miles of hiking trails.

Accommodations:

(some of our facilities are handicapped accessible)

Lodges are fully equipped with bunks and mattresses, electricity, running water in kitchen, and refrigerator, some with cooking stoves, tables, benches and a heat source. Pathfinder, Brown Lodge at Rodney Scout Reservation and Indian River, Lasher Building, Yurt Village and Nanticoke Lodge at Henson Scout Reservation have indoor bathroom facilities and ovens. All others have latrines nearby.

Bunkhouses are heated with a woodstove and have electricity. Fire rings with picnic tables are provided for cooking and eating outside. Latrines and frost free spigots are nearby.

Shelters Rodney features 3-sided Adirondack shelters. Henson features pavilion and hut type shelters. Bunks, fire rings, picnic tables are provided. There is no electricity or heat source. Latrines and frost free spigots are nearby.

Tent sites include fire ring and picnic tables. Bring your own tent. Some tent sites at Rodney and Henson also have pavilions. Latrines and frost free spigots are nearby.
