Follow the steps below to get the training you need to succeed!

Step 1: Required Training

 before registering and beginning your

volunteer service with youth.

Every Scout Deserves a Trained Leader

Units with trained leaders offer stronger, mission-aligned programs that attract and retain Scouts and volunteers.

They might even have more fun!



NOTE:

Safeguarding Youth Training (SYT) used to be called Youth Protection Training (YPT). Current training is mandatory for **all** registered leaders and adults attending campouts.

Consult the online <u>Guide to Safe Scouting</u> for the most current youth protection requirements.

Step 2: Position-Specific Training

• Take the training tailored to your position either in person, online, or in combination. *Note:* Some roles require an in-person, weekend-long skills training and online Hazardous Weather training to be fully trained. Ask your unit leader or committee training chair if yours does.



 You've also earned a Trained patch for your uniform!


Next: Ask about supplemental training opportunities to *really* level up your leadership skills while strengthening your unit!

Find Your Position-Specific Training Online



Create an account or **log in** to your account on **my.Scouting.org**.

Pro Tip: Use the same login and password for all your Scouting accounts, such as Scoutbook.




Click the **My Training** box in the lower left corner of this box on your my. Scouting.org landing page.

This will automatically direct you to your personal **Safeguarding Youth and Volunteer Training Center** page.




Complete **Safeguarding Youth Training** if you haven't yet done so. Print your **certificate** to submit with your adult application.

If your Youth Protection Training has expired, retake it now to **renew** your ability to participate in your Scouting role.



Under **Training Course by Program**, click the program your position serves (e.g., Cub Scouting, Scouts BSA, Venturing).

The next screen shows **Learning Plans** for your program. Select your position. On the next screen, click the blue **Enroll** button.



You will now find the training modules for this position in your **My Learning** tab, under **Learning Plans**.

Click any plan in your **Learning Plans** to Start or Resume the online learning plan for your position. It does not need to be completed all at once.
