



PETER JAMES (JAMIE) PYLE

Jamie's Scouting journey unofficially started at 4 months old when he lived at Rodney Scout Reservation with his parents Jeff (Eagle Scout) and Carla who worked there for many years. Jamie officially became a scout when he joined Troop 56 at age 11, where he was active for 7 years and earned his Eagle Scout Award (1992).
