

James and Elizabeth Clark "Pappy" Memorial Award

This award will be given annually to one youth Arrowman for excellence in community service, Scouting advancement, and academic excellence. All registered Arrowmen under the age of twenty-one are eligible to receive this award. Nominations are to be submitted to the Lodge Secretary on behalf of the Lodge Key 3 for selection and the award will be presented at the annual Lodge Banquet. The selection will be based on all years the youth has participated in Scouting. Criteria for selection will be as follows:

Community Service: The Arrowman must show a willingness to serve his community beyond the service projects required for Scouting advancement.

Scouting Advancement: The Arrowman must be actively advancing through the Scouts BSA or Venturing programs while also helping others advance.

Academic Excellence: The Arrowman must show excellence in academics. Recognition for special achievements will be a key for selection.
